# SOME FOOD FOR THOUGHT...

Do you love God or yourself first? Do you believe the church is meant to reach out to the lost, or do you get lost in doing church? Do you believe Jesus is the Lord and Savior, or do you believe Jesus to be a lord and helper? Do you get connected to the Holy Spirit, or is that your pastor's and elders' responsibility? Do you get involved to help others, or do you get involved to help yourself? Do you believe others are welcomed as they are, or do they need to conform to your expectations?

At times, we tend to focus intently on what we want and forget to look at what God wants. In difficult times, people hold on to what they already know - like clinging to a rope above a dark foggy hole. We don't know what is below our feet.
